"Although it might be hot summer nights with temperature gauge reading 82 degrees Fahrenheit at 2:00 A.M., waking up at such an hour to fetch drinking water, while the rest of the city in deep slumber, is a tedious task even for the most dedicated and ardent assistant of our community. Such has been the case in Asha Niketan. With the monsoon failing to quench the thirst of perched, bone-dry earth for two successive seasons, an assistant had to wake up at that hour every morning to catch the drinking water released for just an hour from water supply board and store it in pots to provide for the day's needs. Now the problem has been solved- thanks to friends of Usha in the U.S.A. Two sumps have been installed to store the water when it flows. When at meetings this particular assistant nods his head we know that is approval rather than him nodding off to sleep".
